We are pleased to inform you that PENDLETON COUNTY SCHOOLS is implementing a new provision available to select schools participating in the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs called the Community Eligibility Pathway (CEP) for School Year 2017-2018.

What does this mean for you and your children who attend Brandywine Elementary School, Franklin Elementary School and North Fork Elementary School?

Great news for you and your students! Your child(ren) are eligible to receive a healthy breakfast and lunch at school at **no charge** to your household each day of the 2017-2018 school year. Your child(ren) will be able to participate in these meal programs without paying a fee or submitting a meal application.

Your child(ren) are eligible for free meals at the school in which they are currently enrolled. If they eat meals at or transfer to another school that does not qualify for the Community Eligibility Pathway during 2017-2018, you will be responsible for any potential meal charges.

For children attending Pendleton County Middle/High School, regular meal prices apply. An application for free/reduced price meals must be completed for these children to determine if they qualify for free or reduced price meals.
