SCHOOL BUSES RETURN TO THE HIGHWAYS
SOME CHANGES IN ROUTES

School will be opening for students on Thursday, August 18 and motorists are cautioned to be on the alert for students walking and waiting for buses along the highways of the county. Motorists are also cautioned to be especially alert for buses that are stopped on the highway for the purpose of loading or unloading students. It is a violation of state law to pass a school bus in either direction when the bus has its red lights flashing. Drivers will be making practice runs on Wednesday, August 17th.

The safety of our children is in the capable hands of our drivers. Distractions caused by students who don't follow the rules threaten the health and safety of others. Parents are encouraged to talk with their children about the importance of good bus riding behavior. The driver needs to focus on what is going on outside of the bus.

School bus schedules for Pendleton County for the 2011-2012 school year:

1. ~~Jason Bowers~~ Calvin Bailey(#277): Upper North Fork Road and Snowy Mtn. To Cherry Grove to North Fork Elementary School and Franklin Elementary School, then to Pendleton County High School.
2. Charlotte Hoover (#177): Moyers Store to State Line; across Hiner Mill Road to Black Thorn to Sinnett's Lane; Moatstown to Rt. 220 including stops on Rt. 220 to Franklin Schools.
3. ~~Rodney Hedrick~~ Lynn Warner (#5410): Beginning at the Franklin side of Crummett's Run, to the South end of Dry Run Road to Thorn Spring Road, South to Sinnett's Lane to Sandy Ridge; then to Propst Gap and continue to Franklin schools.
4. Kevin Gonshor (#5310): Dickenson Mountain; then to Smith Creek Road; then to Franklin Elementary; then to Entry Mountain; then to Franklin Schools.
5. ~~Lynn Warner~~ Sam Harper(#977): County line to Swedlin Valley and Oak Flat, to Brandywine Elementary School, then on to Pendleton County Middle/High School and Franklin Elementary School..
6. Steve Lambert (#953): Beginning in Bennett Gap to Timber Ridge, and turn around in the Simoda area, going to Rt. 33 at Gateway, then on to the Riverton area for

pickups, then going South on Rt. 28 to North Fork Elementary School.

7. Polly Hartman (#7704): Deer Run area beginning on Troublesome Valley Road at Rt. 33 and ending on Kiser Gap Road; continue on Rt. 33 to Franklin schools.
8. Wayne Price (#077): Beginning pickups at Bobbie Armstrong's in Crummett's Run area, then to Big and Little Stoney Run area, and making pickups along the way to Brandywine Elementary School, then to the Franklin Schools.
9. ~~Sam Harper~~ Jason Bowers (#278): Beginning pickups in Brushy Fork area to Rt. 21, then South to County Line, turn around going North on Rt. 21 to Stoney Run Road, then to the Navy Base for pickups, and on to Brandywine Elementary School, then to Pendleton County Middle/High School and Franklin Elementary School.
10. Randy Roberson (#7709): Begin at County Line on South Mill Creek Road, continue through Brushy Run Road to North end of Jake Hill, meet contract drivers on Jake Hill Road, continue to Franklin schools.
11. Lisa Raines (#247): Smith Mountain Road to Rt. 28, then South on Rt. 28 to the 4U Restaurant, turns left onto Rt. 9 going onto the Harper Gap Road and the Harmon Hills Road to Riverton, where meeting other buses, then to Roots Run and on to North Fork Elementary School.
12. James Waybright (#7804): Beginning in Miller's Run then to Broad Run continue to Brandywine Lake Area to Brandywine Elementary School, then to Pendleton County Middle/High School and Franklin Elementary School.
13. Randal Smith (#6507): Route beginning on Pretty Ridge area, making pickups along the way through Reeds Creek to Rt. 33 on North Fork Flats, then going East on Rt. 33 through Friends Run and including Buffalo Hill area, on to the Franklin Schools.
14. Jimmie Bennett (#147): Northern end of Timber Ridge to base of Allegheny Mountain; then on Rt. 33 and 28 to Seneca Rocks; continue on Rt. 33/28 to Riverton to Community Building to make exchange with bus #7708 and #247; then proceed through Bland Hills to Monkeytown; then proceed to North Fork Elementary School.
15. Dempsey Thompson (#7809): Route beginning at Grant County line on Rt. 220 South on to Franklin schools.
16. Diana Redman (#7708): Roaring Creek Road to Onego; then up Brushy Run; then proceed to Riverton Community Building to make exchanges; then proceed

through Roots Run to Rt. 33; continue to Pendleton County High School.

17. Wanda Wimer (#7711): Snowy Mtn. To Rt. 220 to County Line; return to Rt. 220 to Painters Point Area; on to Franklin schools.
18. Wayne Vandevander (#6509): Begin at Ridge Road on Rt. 220 and continue on Ridge Road to Schmucker Road and Corner Road to Rt. 220 to Ruddle, turn around at North end of Buffalo Hills Road and on to Franklin Schools.
19. ~~Jill Huffman~~ Joe Mullens (#7707): Begin at Big Mountain, return to Rt. 28, then to Elk Mountain, continue Northward to Cherry Grove to North Fork Elementary School, then to Pendleton County Middle/High School and may return to North Fork Elementary School based on need.
20. ~~Calvin Bailey~~ Jill Huffman (#3508): Beginning on Hunting Ground Area to Teter Gap Area, to North Fork Elementary School, then to Upper Timber Ridge and return to North Fork Elementary School.
21. Contract Driver will bring students from Mitchell Mountain and Siple Mountain area and from Corner Road to meet Bus # 977.
22. Contract Driver will bring students from Smoke Hole to Jake Hill Road to meet Bus #7709.
23. Contract Driver will bring students from Cave Mountain to Jake Hill Road to meet Bus #7709.
24. Contract Driver will bring students from Greenawalt Gap to Kline Road to meet Bus #6509.
25. Contract Driver will bring students from Conrad Road to Corner Road to meet Bus #977.

Parents can contact the bus driver serving their area for approximate times for pickups. They should be similar to last year's schedule unless there are major changes in that route schedule.
